 - Requires some previous study in a related area but some prior experience in the subject in order to take Year 2 modules in Option 1
- Requirements for Michaelmas Term and Hilary Term at The Lir Academy (Option 2 above)
 - Requires previous study in a related area and along with a CV that demonstrates relevant experience in the area
